

We are the World: inner and outer space

The philosophical statement "I am the World and the world is me" may seem like an odd or even far-fetched way to begin a lesson on stars and planets; yet the origin of the word "Science" comes from Latin and actually refers to consciousness! That is, awareness or even Being itself. This gives us a clue as to what may really be going on "out there": the closer you begin to observe life, the more you will come to notice that your inner world, and the world around you, are intrinsically aligned. This alignment of Self and World is profoundly supported, at the time of "going to print" with this lesson, by a rare celestial alignment of ~~three~~ five heavenly bodies including the Moon, Venus, Jupiter, Mercury, and one other star/planet that Google was unable to mention, but which I observed myself. The five celestial bodies formed a fascinating alignment that looked something like this:



Is it any coincidence that my inner world today and tonight is balanced, harmonious, and full of blossoming fulfillment? Not if we take consciousness, the original meaning of "Science", as our point of departure...

Especially since the time of the Renaissance (1400±) Science has been torn in half by doubters who have tried, in vain, to separate their inner Self from the Outer World. The problematic result is that we are deeply dependent upon external tools to measure reality for us, because we are out of touch with our own God-given intuition.

Furthermore, the art of Science has fallen into a trap of fixed knowledge, whereas Science was never intended to be about certainty or absolute truth, but rather about uncovering revelations (aha! moments) in a mysterious, miraculous and constantly changing universe!

"Universe" - this lovely word is, like "Science", a code-word because it literally means "One Song" (Uni → One and Verse → Song). Herein lies a grand clue about Creation, namely that it is a unified field of vibration; that is, pulses of conscious, loving energy! Like ripples in a cosmic pond!



Let us consider now that the stars, planets, moons, comets and other heavenly bodies in "Outer Space", are, like "you", "me", "us" and "them" points of connectedness in a grand unified field. Let's begin with our own solar system, which consists of a gigantic star we can see and feel, called ~~The~~ Sun (equal to the size of 1 million Earths!!), around which 8 planets, (including Earth), their moons, as well as asteroids (huge rocks), are continuously "falling" in a circular but ever-changing path called an orbit.

The Sun itself is "falling" (i.e. orbiting) around something much gigantic, which scientists do not yet properly understand but which some have called a "Black Hole" (a kind of whirlpool) at the centre of our galaxy, which is called "The Milky Way".

The planets in our own (relatively) small solar system were originally named after the major Gods and Goddesses of the Ancient Greek religion (another clue). They are, in order of proximity (closeness) to the Sun: Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus and Neptune.
